# **Thomas Anile, Reporting SHRM Montgomery Board Member**

On 1/13/2022, the U.S. Supreme Court halted the Occupational Safety and Health Administration's (OSHA) emergency temporary standard (ETS). On 1/25/2022, OSHA announced the withdrawal of its ETS effective 1/26/2022 which will end the lawsuit; however, OSHA has already stated that it is making it a priority to propose a new, permanent COVID-19 safety standard for health care workers. Based on the Supreme Court's decision, the permanent standard will have to look quite different and be narrower in scope than the ETS was.

The Biden Administration's requirement for health insurance to cover the cost of COVID-19 athome tests took effect on January 15th, 2022. Insurance carriers have different options regarding paying for at-home COVID-19 tests ranging from reimbursement to full coverage at in-network locations. If you haven't already, you should contact your insurance provider to determine how it is handling these new requirements.
